## **Dog License**

Dog licenses are available at the Meridian City Clerk's Office located in City Hall at 33 E. Broadway Avenue. To purchase or renew your license, visit the Meridian City Clerk's Office, any of our other approved vendors on the list to the right, or complete and return this form by mail.

Dogs living within the City of Meridian that are over 6-months old must be licensed each year (per MCC 6-2-3). Dog licensing enables Animal Control Officers to reunite dogs with their owners in a timely manner if they are found loose.

The items you will need to obtain your dog's license are:

- Check or Money Order for the appropriate amount.
- Proof of spay/neuter (if applicable) with a copy of a receipt for the procedure and/or documentation from a veterinarian.

License Fees per Dog

\$16.00—Spay or Neutered (must include proof)

\$21.00—Non-Spay or Non-Neutered

Licenses must be renewed annually. A renewal postcard will be sent to the address used upon registration. To update your information, contact the Meridian City Clerk's Office by email (cityclerk@meridiancity.org) or phone (208-888-4433).
