New Facts on cards: • Scientific evidence continues to show chemicals in marijuana permanently change brain function. • K9's can detect marijuana in vape devices. • Teen drug use increases risk of addiction by 40% in adulthood. • MPD K9s are dual-purpose, trained for drug detection & criminal apprehension.



	Results of Satisfaction Survey	 MPD K9s are trained to find marijuana, methamphetamine, cocaine and heroin. K9 certification requires a <i>minimum</i> of 400 training hours. Satisfaction Survey- 15 people answered, good feedback. See attached results for details. Kendall will reach out to Senator Grow to see if he would like to be a guest speaker at an MADC meeting, along with another coalition in Idaho.
